STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating the Fishing in Little Jim Pond, in the County of Franklin.

Fishing in Little Jim pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting fishing in Little Jim pond, in Franklin county, except in the ordinary manner of fly fishing, so-called, with a daily limit of not more than 1 fish in said waters of not less than 14 inches in length.
