IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT Designating a Certain Road as "The Arnold Trail."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

"Arnold Trail" designated. The road leading from North Anson through New Portland, Dead River, Flaggstaff and Eustis to the Canadian border is hereby designated as the "Arnold Trail."
