RESOLVE, Relative to Opening of Dole's Pond and Boyd's Pond in the
Town of Limington in the County of York.

Dole's Pond and Boyd's Pond opened to fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Dole's Pond and Boyd's Pond in the town of Limington in the county of York, to fishing in accordance with the general law of the state and the special laws of York county.
