RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Harrison B. Bowley, Jr.,
of Rockport.

Harrison B. Bowley, Jr.; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Harrison B. Bowley, Jr., of Rockport, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Harrison B. Bowley, Jr., is the son of Harrison B. Bowley, who enlisted July 25, 1862, in Company I, 19th Maine Infantry, and was mustered out and honorably discharged on May 31, 1865. He is now 79 years of age, is unable to work, is without property, and is being helped by the town.
