RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Addie L. Wakefield, of Saco.

Addie L. Wakefield; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$20 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Addie L. Wakefield, of Saco, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Addie L. Wakefield is the daughter of David M. Goodale who enlisted March 6th, 1865, in Company K, 12th Maine Infantry, and had honorable service to the date of his discharge on March 17th, 1866. She is 73 years of age, not able to earn a livelihood, and has had to apply to the city of Saco for assistance.
