STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Charles Brown.

Pension for Charles Brown, discontinued. Resolved: That chapter 105 of the resolves of 1929, providing for a state pension for Charles Brown, be, and hereby is, repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Charles Brown is a patient at the Bangor State Hospital and is being supported at the expense of the State. The pension granted him in 1929 is not necessary for his needs.
