STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Boothbay Harbor Water Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1895, c. 56, § 7, amended. Section 7 of chapter 56 of the private and special laws of 1895, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 7. Board of water commissioners; duties; compensation. Said town is hereby authorized to elect by ballot a board of water commissioners consisting of three persons, the first three chosen to serve one for one year, one for two years, and one for three years and thereafterwards one commissioner shall be elected annually in the month of March to serve for a term of three years, at its annual meeting in March of each year, a board of 3 water commissioners consisting of 3 persons, to serve for the term of 1 year or until their successors are elected and qualified. The term of the present water commissioners shall expire at midnight of the day before said annual March meeting of 1934. Said commissioners are authorized to fix the water rates and determine the conditions and the manner of the water supply, and shall have the general control and management of the water system owned by the town. They shall receive such compensation for their services as may be fixed by the town.
