S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Stamping of Registered Boilers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 54, § 52, amended. Section 52 of chapter 54 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding an extra paragraph at the end of the first paragraph in said section as follows:

‘After a steam boiler has been registered in the department of labor and industry, said department shall furnish, and the owner or user shall stamp, or have stamped, a number as given, on the shell of the boiler in the space commonly used for such purposes, with letters and figures not less than three-eighths of an inch high. Any person, firm or corporation ~~obliterating or covering such number~~ **who fails to so stamp or obliterates or covers such numbers** shall be punished by a fine of **not more than \$100.**’
