STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT to Regulate the Speed of Motor Boats in Certain Waters in the
Belgrade Lakes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Speed of motor boats between Great lake and Long lake, in the Belgrade Lakes. It shall be unlawful for any person to run or operate a motor boat between Great lake and Long lake, in the Belgrade chain of lakes, at a speed in excess of 6 miles an hour.

Sec. 2. Penalty. Whoever violates the provisions of section 1 shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5, nor more than \$20.
