RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for William S. Smith of Alna.

Pension provided for William S. Smith. Resolved: That a pension of \$20 per month be, and hereby is, granted to William S. Smith, of Alna, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension he is now receiving.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

William S. Smith was granted a pension of \$15.00 per month by Chapter 34 of the Resolves of 1929. This amount is not sufficient for his support and he is in need of additional assistance and is worthy of receiving it.
