IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Anna Foley of Lewiston.

Pension provided for Anna Foley. Resolved: That a pension of \$20 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Anna Foley, of Lewiston, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Anna Foley is the daughter of Jeremiah Foley who served in Company G, 9th Regiment of Infantry, Maine Volunteers, from September 21, 1861, to July 13, 1865, when he was honorably discharged. He was in active service and on August 16, 1864, was reported as "Missing in Action".

Anna Foley is advanced in years and not able to earn a livelihood. She is a worthy person and deserving of assistance.
