RESOLVE, in Favor of Charles Hadley, of West Sumner. (P. O. West Paris.)

Charles Hadley compensated for damage done by relocation of road.
Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$100 to be paid to Charles Hadley, of West Sumner, to compensate him for damage done to his property by the relocation of a highway, said sum to be paid from the general highway funds.
