IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Naming That Portion of Township 3, Range 9, W. E. L. S., Piscataquis County, 5,960 Acres, Donated to the State by Percival Proctor Baxter, "Baxter State Park."

"Baxter State Park," designated. Resolved: That portion of Township three (3) Range nine (9) W. E. L. S. in Piscataquis county, containing approximately 5,960 acres of land, donated and conveyed to the state of Maine for public park and recreational purposes by Percival Proctor Baxter (Governor 1921-1925) by his deed dated October 7, 1931, recorded in Piscataquis registry of deeds, book 239, page 109 and accepted by the said state in accordance with the provisions of section 15 of chapter 11 of the revised statutes of 1930, is hereby named "Baxter State Park" in honor of the donor, and the same shall hereafter be so designated on the official maps and records of the state.
