STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Reduce Salaries of County Attorneys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. Suspension of certain laws. From the effective date of this act for a period of 2 years only, the operation of all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby suspended.

Sec. 2. Salaries of county attorneys reduced. County attorneys of the several counties shall receive annual salaries from the state treasury in monthly payments on the last day of each month, as follows :

Sec. 3. Limitation. This act shall remain in effect for a period of 2 years only from the effective date of this act.
