RESOLVE, Relating to Catching of Trout in Certain Waters in Somerset County.

Catching of trout in certain waters, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation that no trout less than 8 inches in length shall be caught and killed in the waters of Johnson Mountain town in upper Cold Stream tract, Parlin Pond town and Misery town, except the waters of Parlin pond in Somerset county.
