S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Jennie Briery, of Gardiner.

Jennie Briery; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Jennie Briery, of Gardiner, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Jennie Briery is 85 years of age and in very feeble health; her mother's brother was a Civil War veteran. His name was Joseph Briery, and his army record is on file in the Adjutant General's office in this state. Jennie Briery is in destitute circumstances, and has no relative able to assist her. She has been a hard working woman, and is deserving of assistance.
