S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Frank E. Wheeler, of
Newport.

Frank E. Wheeler; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Frank E. Wheeler of Newport, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Frank E. Wheeler is the son of Horace H. Wheeler, who had honorable service in the Navy during the Civil War. He is 63 years of age and in poor health. He has been receiving \$12 per month, which is the maximum amount allowed under the general law, but this is not sufficient for his needs. He is deserving of further assistance. He has a wife and young child dependent upon him.
