RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Eunice N. Cunningham,  
of Gardiner.

---

**Eunice N. Cunningham; state pension. Resolved:** That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Eunice N. Cunningham, of Gardiner, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Eunice N. Cunningham is the daughter of Alden Cunningham, said to have served in Co. I, 188th Penn. Vols., during the Civil War. She is 61 years of age, not able to work, and practically all of her funds are exhausted. She will be obliged to call on the city very soon is not aided by the state.
