STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Wallace Taylor of Whitefield.

Pension provided for Wallace Taylor. Resolved: That a pension of \$10 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Wallace Taylor, of Whitefield, to be paid, quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Wallace Taylor is the son of John Davis, a veteran of the Civil War, and the adopted son of John Taylor, a Civil War veteran. He is physically and mentally incapable of earning a livelihood, and is in urgent need of assistance. He has no home, and is being assisted by private charity.
