RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in McWain Pond, or Long Pond, so-called

Fishing in McWain pond, or Long pond, so-called, regulated. Resolved:
That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation limiting the number of black bass to be taken from McWain pond, or Long pond so-called, in Waterford, to not more than 2 per person in any 1 day, and to not more than 4 collectively in any 1 day to the occupants of any 1 boat, canoe, or other conveyance.
