STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Cooper to Withdraw from the Maine Forestry District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Cooper may withdraw from Forestry District. The town of Cooper in the county of Washington may by vote at any meeting of its inhabitants duly called and held, withdraw from the Maine Forestry District. A copy of such vote certified by the town clerk shall be forwarded forthwith to the treasurer of state and to the forestry commissioner and from the time such certified copy is filed in the office of the treasurer of state, said town shall cease to be a part of said forestry district.
