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AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Certain Property from Taxation.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 13, § 6, ¶ III, amended.** Paragraph III of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting at the end of said paragraph the following:

**'Provided, however, that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to a summer camp, or other seasonal resort, which derives a profit on its actual operating and administrative expenses incurred thereat or within the state of Maine, nor to that part of its property from which it receives compensation in the form of rent. Such camp or resort shall keep full financial records which shall at all times be open and available to inspection by the tax assessors of the town or city wherein it is located.'**
