STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Day Mountain Pond, in the Town of Avon.

Fishing in Day Mountain Pond regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation fixing the daily bag limit on trout to be taken from Day Mountain Pond in the town of Avon in the county of Franklin to 15 fish of not less than 7 inches in length.
