STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Repeal the Act Incorporating Number XIV Plantation in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Plantation No. XIV disorganized. The organization of Plantation Number XIV, Eastern Division in Washington County, adopted by said Plantation on October 22nd, 1840, in accordance with the provisions of general law for the organization of plantations contained in chapter 89 of the laws of 1840, is hereby surrendered, provided, however, that the corporate existence, powers, duties and liabilities of said plantation shall survive for the purpose of prosecuting and defending all pending suits and causes of suits to which said plantation is, or may be, a party and all needful process growing out of the same, including provisions for the payment of all or any judgments or debts which may be rendered against such town or exist in favor of any creditor.
- Sec. 2. Effective date of act. This act shall become effective when approved by the legal voters of Plantation Number XIV at any legally called annual or special meeting of the legal voters of said plantation under an article placed in the warrants of said plantation for that purpose.
