RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Fred E. Hilton of Pittston.

Pension provided for Fred E. Hilton. Resolved: That a pension of \$20 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Fred E. Hilton, of Pittston, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Fred E. Hilton is the son of Oran Hilton who enlisted August 31, 1863, in Company E, 29th Maine Infantry, and served until honorably discharged August 22, 1865. He is 56 years of age and incapacitated by deafness and poor eyesight. He has no settlement in any city or town in Maine and at the present time is being supported as a State charge.
