STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Extending Open Season on Mousam River.

Open season on Mousam river, extended. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation extending the open season for fishing in the Mousam river in the county of York from the mouth of said river up to the point where the Boston and Maine railroad bridge crosses said Mousam river in the town of Sanford, from April 1st to December 15th, both days inclusive of each year, except that no trout, salmon, white perch or black bass shall be taken from said river from September 15th to the 1st day of the following April.
