STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Turner.

Turner compensated for fighting forest fires. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$1000, to be paid to the town of Turner; this sum to be a settlement in full for all claims against the state of Maine, for the fighting of forest fires during the years of 1931 and 1932, and to be paid from the general funds of the state.
