IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Hattie Boynton of Montville.

Pension granted to Hattie Boynton. Resolved: That a pension of \$10 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Hattie Boynton, of Montville, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Hattie Boynton is the daughter of Charles Morrison who was in service from August 19, 1863, to May 22, 1865, and received an honorable discharge. She is in need of financial assistance.
