STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Valdimir B. Jones of Waldo.

Pension provided for Valdimir B. Jones. Resolved: That a pension of \$8 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Valdimir B. Jones, of Waldo, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Valdimir B. Jones is the daughter of Daniel D. Stevenson, who served in Co. L, 32nd Massachusetts Regiment, during the Civil War. She is 61 years of age, a Widow, and without any relatives to help her. Her health is poor, and she is in need of assistance.
