RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Elida F. Whitcomb of
Montville.

Pension provided for Elida F. Whitcomb. Resolved: That a pension of \$8 per month be, and hereby is granted to Elida F. Whitcomb, of Montville, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Elida F. Whitcomb is the daughter of Abner F. Sheldon who served in the 15th Reg. of Maine Inf., during the Civil War, and was honorably discharged at the expiration of his service. She is 60 years of age, and quite lame as the result of rheumatic fever. Mrs. Whitcomb's home was burned about a year ago, and she lost everything she had.
