STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Licensing of Aircraft.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 30, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 30 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 8. Examination and licensing fees. No airman shall operate an aircraft commercially within this state without a permit or license certificate issued by the secretary of state.

All aircraft owned by non-residents shall be inspected and registered by the secretary of state before operating commercially within this state.

The secretary of state shall collect fees as follows:

Permit or license certificate	\$ 5.00
Inspection of plane	15.00
Non-resident inspection and registration	30.00
Registration of plane	5.00
Examination and test of applicant for license	15.00
Student permit	1.00
Transfer of registration	1.00

Pilots licensed within this state as required by the provisions of this act shall be exempt from examination and test flight fees.'
