STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend the Law Providing for Continuous Revision of the Statutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The paragraph numbered (1) in section 2 of chapter 10 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1) During each session of the legislature to draft public laws at the request of members of the legislature provided the request for such drafting be made during the period expiring at least one week before the time set as a limit for the reception of public legislation and to revise all legislation so far as may be practicable so that it shall be in conformity with and may be properly inserted in the revised statutes, under the direction of the senate and house of representatives;

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" TO SENATE PAPER 659

Amend Senate Paper No. 659 by adding thereto the following section:

Sec. 2. The paragraph numbered 3 in section 2 of chapter 210 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby amended by striking out said paragraph and substituting in place thereof the following:

'After each session of the legislature, to cause the public laws to be printed on good paper and in suitable type and to distribute the same within the state to all citizens making a request therefor.'
