IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND
THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of Bridgton Center Village Corporation

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L. 1927, c. 70, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 70 of the private and special laws of 1927 is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 2. Powers. Said corporation is hereby invested with the power, at any legal meeting called for that purpose, to raise such sums of money as may be sufficient for the construction, purchase, repair and preservation of 1 or more fire engines, combination motor fire trucks, engine houses, hose, buckets, ladders, ladder houses, and other apparatus for the extinguishment of fire ; for the construction of reservoirs and aqueducts ; for the procuring of water for fire purposes and for organizing within the limits of said territory an efficient fire department ; for the construction and repair of sewers and a general sewerage system ; for lighting the streets and for watchmen, or other officers, within the limits of said corporation and for the purchase and repair of any other object or thing deemed necessary for enforcing or putting into effect any by-law which has been or which may hereafter be adopted by said corporation. **Said corporation shall also be invested with the power, at any legal meeting called for that purpose to authorize its assessors and treasurer to hire money for any of the purposes**

named in this section in anticipation of the collection of the taxes for the current year and give the note or notes of the corporation therefor, said loan not to exceed the total assessment for such year and such notes not to be given for a period of more than 1 year.'
