**AN ACT Relating to the Issuance of Licenses for the Operation of Motor
Vehicles**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 29 § 65, amended. Section 65 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 65. Licenses for operation of motor vehicles. No person shall operate any motor vehicle unless duly licensed by the secretary of state to operate such motor vehicle. All licenses to operate motor vehicles shall be valid for 1 year after the date of issuance of such license.'
