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**AN ACT Providing for the Merger or Consolidation of Banks**

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

**R. S. c. 57, § 95-G, amended.** Section 6 of chapter 93 of the public laws of 1933 now appearing as section 95-G of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 95-G. Merger or consolidation authorized.** The ~~court~~ **bank commissioner, on application duly filed,** may order the merger or consolidation of ~~said~~ a trust company with any other banking institution, state or federal, with the consent of said latter banking institution, and prescribe the mode of procedure for said merger or consolidation and the terms and conditions thereof.'
