**AN ACT Relating to Closed Seasons in the Several Waters of the State.**

---

**Emergency Preamble.** Whereas, the present fishing restrictions prevent citizens from catching fish for food during the winter season; and

Whereas, many of our citizens are in dire need of food; and

Whereas, the immediate removal of these restrictions will enable many persons to catch food for their families; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, now, therefore

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 21, repealed.** Section 21 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.

**Emergency Clause.** In view of the emergency created as recited in the preamble this act shall take effect when approved.
