STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicles of Seven Feet or More in Width

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 29, § 82, ¶ 5, amended. Paragraph 5 of section 82 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Green lamp may be used. Every motor vehicle of 7 feet or over in width shall have thereon at the extreme left on the body, I amber or green lamp visible for a distance of at least 200 feet ahead of such vehicle. Motor vehicles requiring a light hereunder may, in lieu of such light, be equipped with an adequate reflector conforming as to color and marginal location to the requirements for such light.'
