STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Poll-taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Poll-tax. A poll-tax shall be assessed upon every male inhabitant of the state above the age of 21 years whether a citizen of the United States or an alien, in the manner provided by law unless he is exempted therefrom by this chapter, which said poll-tax shall be three dollars \$2.50.'
