STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND
THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Abatement of Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Petitions, etc., for abatement of taxes, limitation on. All petitions or actions brought for the abatement of taxes due to plantations, towns, cities, counties or the state must be instituted within 12 months of the date that they are due, notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary.

All acts, or parts of acts, inconsistent herewith, are hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this act.
