STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Whiting to Withdraw from the Maine Forestry District

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whiting may withdraw from Forestry District. The town of Whiting in the county of Washington may by vote at any meeting of its inhabitants duly called and held, withdraw from the Maine Forestry District. A copy of such vote certified by the town clerk shall be forwarded forthwith to the treasurer of state and to the forestry commissioner and from the time such certified copy is filed in the office of the treasurer of state, said town shall cease to be a part of said forestry district.
