STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND
THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Compensation of State Employees

Whereas a salary reduction based upon sliding scale graph was put in operation as provided in chapter 81 of the private and special laws of 1933, and

Whereas, said salary reduction has effected a total saving to the state equal to and exceeding the amount based upon said sliding scale graph, and

Whereas the classification, readjustment and equalization plan provided for in section 3 of said act has not been completed and put in effect,

Now therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Compensation sliding scale plan completed. The classification, readjustment and equalization plan contemplated in section 3 of said act is hereby completed and put in effect.

Sec. 2. Plan to be made effective. Said classification, readjustment and equalization shall be made effective by the state budget officer in accordance with the plan begun by the joint standing committee on salaries and fees of the 86th legislature, acting under joint order number 34.
