IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND
THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Impose a Tax on Admissions to Moving Pictures.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Admission to moving pictures. A tax of 2 cents on each and every ticket of admission sold by moving picture houses shall be imposed and collected by the State; said proceeds to be treated as general revenue of the state. The state tax assessor is hereby authorized to issue rules and regulations for the carrying out of the provisions of this act.
