IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND
THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Validating the Acts of Assessors Since 1922.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Acts of assessors and collectors validated. The acts and doings of the assessors of taxes of the several plantations, towns and cities since the year 1928 in the assessments of real estate in their respective plantations, towns and cities, and the acts and doings of the collector of taxes of such several plantations, towns and cities in the advertising and sale of real estate for taxes are hereby validated and made legal and the title of the purchaser of such real estate at the tax sale made by the collector of taxes of such plantations, towns and cities is hereby confirmed and made valid and legal, notwithstanding any omissions, or errors, or failure to conform to the law in making such assessment, advertising and sale during said period, provided said deeds have been duly recorded in the registry of deeds office in the several counties before any subsequent sale incumbrance or lien has been placed thereon.
