STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Charles Springer, of Hartland.

Charles Springer compensated for accident. Resolved: That there be and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$250 to be paid to Charles Springer, of Hartland, to compensate him for injuries received while in the employ of the state highway department, to be paid from the highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Springer was injured on September 20, 1933, to the extent of a broken leg, while in the employ of the state highway commission. As the accident occurred by his being thrown from his motorcycle while he was returning to his home from his place of employment, it is not covered by the Workmen's Compensation Act. He is 27 years of age, and this is a very worthy case.
