**RESOLVE, in Favor of a State Pension for Ethel W. Knowlton of  
Monson.**

**Ethel W. Knowlton; teacher's pension. Resolved:** That a pension of \$275 per year be, and hereby is, granted to Ethel W. Knowlton of Monson, Maine to be paid quarterly from the appropriation for teacher's pensions. Said pension shall begin April 1, 1934 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Ethel W. Knowlton will be 60 years old in a few months and has taught as a teacher for over 20 years in Maine. Under the requirements of the present law, the last 15 years of service must be within the state, whereas Ethel W. Knowlton has taught here for the last 10 years only, the other 10 years of service in Maine being some time ago. She is unable to teach any longer.
