## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the City of Old Town.

Old Town reimbursed for tuition furnished to members of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians. Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the City of Old Town the sum of \$574.68 to reimburse the said city for tuition furnished to members of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians attending Old Town High School during school year 1932-1933. This payment shall be made from the regular appropriations provided for tuition for the years 1933-1934 and 1934-1935 and said amount to be used as an offset against any amounts due the state from the city of Old Town.
