SENATE AMENDMENT A TO LEGISLATIVE DOCUMENT 138

---

Amend Legislative Document 138 by striking out the title and substituting in place thereof the following: "Resolve proposing the amendment of the twenty-sixth amendment to the Constitution relating to the manufacture and sale of intoxicating liquors by vesting full control in the electors."

**Sec. 2.** Amend Legislative Document 138 by striking out the word "repealed" at the end of the second line and substituting in place thereof the following words: "amend by striking out all of said section and inserting in place thereof the following: 'The legislature shall pass no act regulating or permitting the manufacture or sale of beverages containing more than four per cent of alcohol by volume as an emergency measure within the meaning of article XXXI of the amendments to the Constitution unless such act itself contains a provision for its submission to the vote of the electors.'"

**Sec. 3.** Amend Legislative Document 138 by striking out the question in the twelfth and thirteenth lines of said document and substituting in place thereof the following: "shall the constitution be amended by eliminating the present absolute prohibition against the manufacture and sale of intoxicating liquors and vesting the control of legislation dealing with the subject of intoxicating liquors in the electors?"
