**AN ACT Relating to Wages of Employees on Public Works Under State
Supervision.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Minimum wage scale. No employee working on any public works which are under the supervision of the state shall receive less than 40 cents per hour. This provision shall be incorporated in all contracts let by the state for any such public works. The commissioner of labor is hereby empowered to investigate any dispute or controversy arising in connection with the provisions of this act and his decision in the matter shall be final.
