**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Frankfort.**

---

**Fishway in dam at Marsh stream; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$6000, in favor of the town of Frankfort, to be expended for the building of a fishway to be placed in the dam at Marsh Stream in the town of Frankfort; said sum to be taken from the general maintenance fund of the department of inland fisheries and game.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The construction of this fishway will, according to the testimony of local experienced fishermen, permit salmon from the Penobscot river to migrate to the Marsh stream which flows through the towns of Winterport, Frankfort and Monroe, and is presented at the request of many fishermen and farmers of Waldo county.
