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**AN ACT Relating to Facsimile Signature of Clerks of Courts.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. Facsimile signatures of clerks of courts provided for.** A facsimile of the signature of the clerks of the supreme judicial and superior courts, in the state, imprinted by or at his direction upon any writ, summons, subpoena, order or notice or order of attachment, except executions and criminal process, shall have the same validity as his written signature.

**Sec. 2. Repealing clause.** All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this provision are hereby repealed.
